BACKGROUND

- Renal calculus disorders
- Urethral Strictures
- Injectables for the use of male and female incontinence. (Dr. Taylor is on the international advisory board for Q-Med.)
- PVP Laser prostatectomy
- Minimally Invasive Ureteric Stents.

Dr. Taylor has developed and patented a device which makes cystoscopic retrieval of a ureteric stent unnecessary. This device will be undergoing trials in 2005 in adults, transplant patients and children undergoing reconstructive surgery of the urinary tract.
