



Postdoctoral Research Fellow - Transplantation

The Department of Urologic Sciences invites applications for a junior **Postdoctoral Research Fellow** position for a highly motivated biomedical research scientist. The successful candidate will have a PhD, completed within the last 4 years, preferably in preclinical lab research or a relevant area; working knowledge of novel therapeutic solution development (e.g. antibody and cell therapies, and organ preservation in transplantation) and of surgical animal models would be an asset; Demonstrated ability to work productively in a collaborative research team. Excellent communication, planning and organization skills are essential.

The applicant will participate in multiple preclinical research projects as a team member in the Department of Urologic Sciences while he/she is encouraged to develop his/her own research interests. The major responsibilities include: designing and performing experiments, presenting the work progress in the department, writing grants and manuscripts, and providing support and training to the students/trainees in the lab.

This position is initially for one year with the possibility of extension.
